Cancellation Policy (Acceptance required for registration)

Your \$350.00 (or \$100/person) deposit is non-refundable and secures your registration. The remaining balance of camp fees are refundable up to 30 days prior to your camp's start date. Within 30 days of your camp's start date, the remaining balance may be refunded only if that camp is full and we are able to replace your spot with someone from our waiting list. All cancellations must be received in writing. Refunds for camp fees are not made for any campers unable to attend, arriving late, or leaving early for any reason, including health.

Complete Release Waiver of Claim and Assumption of Risk

In consideration of permission granted now or in the future by the Green Bay bible Camp Society (the 'Society') to use the Society's facilities in the Province of British Columbia, I, the undersigned, release the Society and its employees, representatives, volunteers, directors and officers (collectively called 'Green Bay') from all liability and waive as against Green Bay all recourse, loss or damage, including any consequential damage or loss, claims, causes of action of any kind whatsoever that I may suffer or that my next of kin may suffer as a result of participation in the activities (the "Activities") carried out on and in the vicinity of the Society's property (the 'Campgrounds') including the waterfront and dock adjacent to the Campgrounds (the 'Waterfront') and off-site activities, and I voluntarily accept the physical risk together with the legal risk, thereby expressly giving up any right of legal action.

I further acknowledge and agree:

To follow the rules and regulations established by Green Bay Bible Camp.

That lifeguards employed by the Society are on duty at the Waterfront only during designated hours and that I assume a greater degree of risk by using the Waterfront outside of the designated hours.

That some of the aforesaid risks and hazards are foreseeable but others are not.

That I nevertheless freely and voluntarily assume all the aforesaid risks and hazards and that, accordingly, my use of the Campgrounds and Waterfront facilities while participating in any Activities shall be entirely at my own risk.

That I have carefully read this COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK and that I fully understand same and that I am freely and voluntarily executing the same.

That I understand that Green Bay does not and will not permit me to participate in 2010 Family Camp(s) unless I sign the COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK which applies to all of the Activities and that the terms of this Agreement need not be brought to my attention each time I am participating in Activities in order to be effective.

That I give Green Bay the right to use photographs and videos of me involved in Activities for promotional purposes.

That I verify that I am 19 years of age or older. (Parent or legal guardian must sign for minor).

That this COMPLETE RELEASE, WAIVER OF CLAIM AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK is binding on myself, my heirs, my executors, administrators, personal representatives, and assigns.

Registration for the summer of 2010 Family Camps begins Wednesday, January 6, 2010 at 9 AM PST. Forms and payment received in our office prior to this date and time will be marked as received Thursday, January 7, 2010 at 9 AM. All camp spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

IF YOU ARE MAILING IN YOUR REGISTRATION - The completed registration form including the signed waiver, checked cancellation policy, & complete payment must be obtained before your family's registration can be confirmed.

Post-Dated Cheque Instructions:

- Your cheque(s) (current/post-dated) must be received with registration form in order to be processed. You will receive e-mail confirmation once we have processed your registration.

- If you are paying by post-dated cheque, we only accept single, post-dated payments. Please make cheques payable for no later than **April 29th, 2010**. *NOTE:* Any registration not received in our office and paid in full by April 29, 2010 will be subject to an additional 7% tax on the entire registration amount due to new BC-HST tax guidelines.

Location



From the West

(approximately 7 minutes from Westbank's town center)

1. Coquihalla Hwy to Coquihalla Connector (Highway 97C) to Highway 97
2. Take Highway 97 through the town of Westbank towards Kelowna
3. Turn right at McDonald's onto Gellatly Rd.
4. Follow Gellatly to the lake and turn left at the "T" intersection - you are now on Boucherie Rd.
5. Follow Boucherie for approximately 3 Km., As Boucherie continues up a hill, take the road off to the right. (Green Bay Road)
6. The camp is the second driveway on the right - turn right at the Green Bay Bible Camp sign

From the East

(approximately 10 minutes from downtown Kelowna)

1. Highway 97 through Kelowna and over Lake Okanagan bridge
2. Turn left at the second traffic light onto Boucherie Rd. There will be a Mac's/Esso on that corner
3. Boucherie Road continues through a residential area and heads down to the lake. When you reach the bottom of the hill at lake level, take a sharp left onto Green Bay Rd.
4. The camp is the second driveway on the right - turn right at the Green Bay Bible Camp sign
