

Green Bay Bible Camp Job Description: Boat Driver



Overall Purpose

To provide safe and fun boating activities for campers throughout the summer, ensuring all safety protocols are followed and the vision of Green Bay is fulfilled.

Organizational Structure

This position reports to the Waterfront Coordinator and is also accountable to the Assistant Waterfront Coordinator. Boat Drivers will be a part of the waterfront staff, made up primarily of sr. cabin leaders. Accountable to the Waterfront Coordinator, the boat drivers will also be the authority of boat safety while on the water.

Principle Duties

- Be an example to staff and campers alike in speech and action, on and off the waterfront
- Participate in Waterfront Staff training
- Understand and comply with staff and camper policies (especially those that are applicable to the waterfront) that provide for an efficient and safe camp community.
- Make sure boats are fueled up before and after session times.
- Work with Waterfront Coordinator ensuring boat maintenance is taken care of
- Keep record of boat use through log books
- Cleanliness of boat each day (wiping seats down, windows)
- Ensure that boats are kept in Showroom condition
- Help train the waterfront staff in terms of safe boating practices while out on the water.
- Ensure that required safety equipment and identification are on the boat at all times
- Work with the Waterfront Coordinator to ensure that appropriate emergency procedures for the waterfront are in place.
- Attend morning staff meetings whenever possible

Qualifications

- Strong desire and willingness to serve
- Minimum 18yrs old with High School Diploma or equivalent
- Possess a conviction that safety is first regardless.
- Working knowledge of boats and boating safety
- Possess a valid boat license and current first aid certificate
- Min. 2yrs experience driving tournament boats
- Willing to gain a working understanding of the policies and procedures of GBBC.
