

Overall Purpose

To give guidance, support and leadership to a group of 20 students during each of the two SLUG terms of the summer. The male and female SLUG Coordinators will work closely with their students to help them discover and apply their leadership gifts and abilities.

Organizational Structure

SLUG Coordinators (one male, one female) will report/be accountable to the GBU Manager. These individuals will work in accordance with the other GBU leaders on some occasions as well as the Program, Facilities and Kitchen departments.

Principle Duties

- Oversee and work with the SLUG's.
- Spend quiet time with God on a regular basis
- Be a spiritual mentor to the SLUG's one on one time's and regular group meetings.
- Set aside time each day for the SLUG's to pray together as a group.
- Set time aside each week to pray with the other GBU leaders.
- Plan and teach daily sessions for the SLUG students.
- Responsible for both the encouragement of and, if necessary, the discipline of the SLUG's
- Make schedules for SLUGs daily tasks and responsibilities
- Work in accordance with the Kitchen and Facilities staff to ensure that all of the SLUG duties get accomplished.
- Plan activities for the SLUG's that are on the days that are between camps
- Ensure that the SLUG's get to evening campfire's.
- Enforce the rules and policies of the camp amongst the SLUG's
- Uphold and enforce the camp rules and policies amongst the other summer staff.
- Enforce evening curfew for the SLUG's, and as a member of the Coordinating staff, enforce curfew amongst the other summer staff members as well.
